## BEACH SEASON AT WAUKESHA COUNTY PARKS KICKS OFF MAY 10

All six beaches open daily sunrise to sunset

(Waukesha, WI) – Waukesha County Parks is excited to launch the 2024 beach swimming season at all six beach locations on Friday, May 10.

"The opening of Waukesha County Park System beaches feels like the official start to summer," Waukesha County Executive Paul Farrow said. "Our beaches are at the top of summer to-do lists for so many of our residents and visitors, and I invite everyone to join us in the sun and sand," Farrow added.

Waukesha County Park System beaches will be open with Swim at Your Own Risk (SAYOR) hours seven days a week from sunrise to sunset (pending weather and water conditions).
