Discuss and Consider 2019 Capital Projects, Debt Service, and Non-Departmental Budgets (General Fund, Health & Dental Insurance Fund, Contingency Fund)

Cummings and Duckwitz discussed the proposed 2019 Debt Service Fund which lists total debt at \$14,790,518 – a decrease of \$102,322 from the adopted 2018 budget. The County tax levy in the Debt Service Fund totals \$13,904,500 – an increase of \$350,000.

Expenditures in the Capital Projects budget total \$25,005,200 – an increase of \$6,218,900. The County tax levy in the Capital Projects budget totals \$1,055,927 – a decrease of \$691,073.

Regarding the Non-Departmental Fund, both revenues and expenditures total \$1,862,600 - a decrease of \$143,300 or 7.1%. The County tax levy in Non-Departmental totals \$60,100 - an increase of \$13,900 or 30.1%.

Cummings, Richter, and Duckwitz presented the 2019 Health and Dental Insurance Fund budget which they discussed in detail. No major concerns were voiced.

MOTION: Morris moved, second by Wysocki to tentatively approve the Debt Service budget. Motion carried 7-0.

MOTION: Michalski moved, second by Paulson to tentatively approve the Capital Projects budget. Motion carried 6-0. Wysocki abstained from voting.

MOTION: Dondlinger moved, second by Michalski to tentatively approve the Health & Dental Insurance Fund. Motion carried 7-0.

MOTION: Michalski moved, second by Foti to tentatively approve the Contingency Fund. Motion carried 7-0.

MOTION: Paulson moved, second by Morris to tentatively approve the remainder of the Non-Departmental budget. Motion carried 7-0.

Discuss and Consider Amendments to the 2019 Waukesha County Operating Budget Copies of proposed amendment FIN-N to accept U.S. Department of Justice grant funds for the County's Pretrial Diversion Project were distributed which, in part, will fund a 1.0 full-time equivalent sunset paralegal position in the District Attorney's Office. The 2019 cost of this position is \$73,017 in 2019 and will be fully funded with the federal grant funds. In total, the grant award for 2019 is \$188,612 for the Criminal Justice Collaborating Council, and \$78,607 of that goes to the District Attorney's Office.

MOTION: Wysocki moved, second by Foti to adjourn at 11:00 a.m. Motion carried 7-0.
