Dunn called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m.

Approve Minutes from May 26, 2020 Meeting

Continue to Discuss Changes to Marsy's Law and Impact on Court Operations

Dunn stated that there have been discussions regarding motions and sealing. A motion to seal must be filed with every victim key, statement, and restitution statement, as well as the order from the office. The motion and order must remain separate documents and both need to be filed. Dunn will forward the sample forms to the committee.

There is no way to make the Confidential Crime Victim(s) Information form (CR-247) to be a confidential document when uploaded into CCAP. The Clerk of Court's Office will share the form with the Department of Corrections.

Schimel arrived at 2:15 p.m.

Peterson and Paz have discussed issues regarding turning over restitution collections from DOC to DOR.

Lazar stated that the judges consider Riverside reviews to be similar in nature to signing a warrant, and therefore, are not considered a "proceeding."

Dunn expressed a concern with judges asking how the victims feel about extensions requested for nocontact orders. She said that the inquiry could put the victim at further risk, particularly if the victim has expressed that they do not want to be near the accused for whatever reason. The District Attorney's (DA) Office informs victims if the Assistant DA is requesting a no-contact order. If the victim does not want that action to ultimately be taken, the victim may write or speak to the court.
