

**OPEN MEETING MINUTES
WAUKESHA COUNTY
TEMPORARY CHAPTER 980 COMMITTEE MEETING
JANUARY 29, 2020**

COMMITTEE MEMBERS PERSENT: Chair Antwayne Robertson, Jason Fruth, Jason Popp, Erik Weidig

GUESTS PRESENT: Jim Landwehr

NOT PRESENT: Angie Serwa (by phone), William Seymour, Dale Shaver

Robertson called the meeting to order at 11:31 a.m.

With one typographical error in the minutes corrected, Weidig moved, second by Fruth to approve the January 15 meeting minutes. Motion carried 4-0.

Weidig reported on the January 28 court hearing, which included discussion on whether this property satisfied statutory criteria. The judge found that he did not have to make a decision on whether the paintball facility qualifies as a youth center or not, as based on the measurements provided, the facility exceeded the 1500 foot distance limit from the residence property. The court agreed the property is a statutorily appropriate location. An order will be entered setting forth a supervised release schedule. The next step is for DHS to prepare and submit a plan by February 24. The next hearing is February 28 at which time the court will determine if the DHS supervised release plan is approved. Given the Temporary Chapter 980 Committee has completed its task, Weidig requested and the court agreed to excuse the committee in further court proceedings. To the call of the chair, this committee will conclude. If a non-approval is determined by chance, the court will direct the committee to resume the 120 days property search process.

Chair Robertson thanked the committee members for all of their work and time throughout the process, and is hopeful the property goes through.

Robertson will reach out to vendors and law enforcement with the status update as a courtesy.

Discussion on future offenders in the pipeline. No formal communication requests were received at this time. At such time a formal notification is presented, the Temporary Chapter 980 Committee will activate.

Popp explained the next steps and work of his staff at the Department of Justice with law enforcement and DHS once this placement is approved.

Robertson moved to suspend the committee at this time.

Motion to adjourn at 11:44 a.m. by Weidig, second by Fruth. Motion carried 4-0.
