# Discuss and Consider Modifications to the Following Classification Specifications: Detective, Sign and Signal Maintenance Worker, Crew Leader, and Patrol Worker

The following sentences are being requested: "May be called upon at any time to respond to emergency situations and/or major incidents, as determined by supervision," and "Ability to respond at any time to emergency situations and/or major incidents, as determined by supervision." Staff went on to discuss the justification for the added language.

MOTION: Crowley moved, second by Walz to approve modifications to the Detective classification specification as presented. Motion carried 7-0.

Barwick advised staff are requesting to modify the class specs for Sign and Signal Maintenance Worker, Crew Lead, and Patrol Worker to the Class A CDL minimum requirement to provide greater opportunities for recruiting.

MOTION: Mitchell moved, second by Michalski to approve modifications to the Sign and Signal Maintenance Worker, Crew Leader, and Patrol Worker classification specifications as presented. Motion carried 7-0.
