Approve Minutes from April 14, 2021 Meeting

Motion: Dussault moved, second by Eiring, to approve the minutes from the April 14, 2021 meeting of the CJCC Pretrial Committee. Motion passed without a negative vote.

Update on Efforts to Remove Defendants from Intoxicated Driver Intervention Program (IDIP) Waitlist through Bail Modification Hearings

Dorow reminded attendees that if a defendant is not eligible for IDIP due to the waitlist, in order to be eligible for SCRAM CAM, SCRAM CAM must be ordered. As she was reviewing the cases that had the WCS letter filed from the previous meeting and removing IDIP as a condition of bond, she noticed that some defendants with an initial appearance in January, had not been on SCRAM CAM.

Status of Pretrial Supervision and Pretrial IDIP Caseloads and Waitlists

Eiring reported that the Pretrial Supervision program has just under 100 participants and has received more referrals within the last week. IDIP has approximately 125-130 participants and has room to add additional defendants.

Update on 7/14 Presentation by Barb Hankey, Manager of Oakland County, MI Community Corrections, on Drug Testing as a Condition of Bail

Dorow provided attendees with a brief biography on Barb Hankey, who will be presenting to the committee on 7/14 on drug testing as a condition of bail.

Continued Discussion on Update on Efforts to Remove Defendants from Intoxicated Driver Intervention Program (IDIP) Waitlist through Bail Modification Hearings

Marin stated that 20 cases from the IDIP waitlist still remain unaddressed. Some of the 20 cases did not have bail addressed at hearings, others have a plea and sentencing already scheduled, and others have hearings scheduled farther out.
