MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 5, 2019


The Waukesha County Sheriff's Grievance Committee was called to order on February 5, 2019 at 3:00 p.m., by Chairman Raasch. In the Matter of Charges Filed against Deputy Erich Stubbe dated December 6, 2018. Present were committee members Steliga, Del La Mora and Raasch. Also present was representative of the Sheriff's Department, Inspector James Gumm. No body appeared on behalf of Deputy Stubbe.

Motion was then made and seconded and was unanimously approved that the Committee go into closed session pursuant to Section 59.26(8)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Presentation was made by the representative of the Sheriff's Department, Inspector Gumm regarding violations of the Sheriff's Department Policies and Procedures: 1.01, 1.07, 1.09 and 1.12. No statement or testimony was made by or on behalf of Deputy Stubbe who did not appear.

Following the closing statement and testimony of Inspector Gumm and questions of the Committee, the Committee reviewed the testimony and record in deliberation, taking into consideration §59.26(b)5m of the Wisconsin Statutes, and rendered its decision in open session, a copy of which is attached hereto.
