Robertson called the meeting to order at 11:41 a.m.

Weidig moved to approve the January 29, 2020 minutes, second by Popp. All in favor 3-0.

Robertson received a list of current properties including rentals. The list has been forwarded to the housing vendors. Robertson will continue to check in with vendors and re-start the process of weekly property updates.

Popp, Wisconsin Department of Corrections, is also currently involved in planning regarding COVID-19. He is not able to screen the list of properties at this time.

Landwehr will continue to run the property search on a weekly basis.

Everyone is aware of who it is the committee is trying to find a placement. Information regarding the victim has been received for mapping purposes.

Popp participated in a meeting last week with law enforcement for release of a special bulletin of sex offenders separate from this.

Weidig reported that Serwa has indicated that DHS will consider Waites as an option of being a landlord for this case. The defense counsel will also be pushing for that. What would DOJ or DHS say about these two individuals residing together? Robertson will follow up with Serwa.

Landwehr asked if this individual is a child offender or adult offender. Weidig was unable to recall, but noted there may be other boundaries to consider. Weidig will let Landwehr know and determine the perimeters. Landwehr will continue to run apartment rentals as well.

The committee will initially meet weekly.

The deadline for the committee to submit a residential option for this case is currently July 11, 2020.

Weidig moved to adjourn, second by Robertson, at 11:54 a.m.
