### Bid for Waukesha County Salt Dome Entrance Repairs Project #2022-18

Kueny Architects has recommended that the contract for this project be awarded to Bulk Storage for a total contract cost of \$95,087.00, comprised of the base bid for the salt dome entrance remodel. Based on information submitted on the proposal form, Bulk Storage has stated that they can complete the work within the County's schedule, completed the non-collusion affidavit, and demonstrated sufficient qualification and responsibility for this project.
