

COUNTY BOARD AGENDA 2nd Meeting, 175th Year of the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors Tuesday, May 26, 2020– 7:00 p.m. Waukesha County Courthouse – Room 350

CONVENE MEETING

Call to Order: Chairman Decker called the meeting to order and led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer.

County Clerk Correspondence & Announcements: County Clerk Wartman announced that County Executive Farrow signed all ordinances from the March 24, 2020 meeting and that five claims had been filed since the March Board Meeting.

Approval of the minutes: Supervisor Howard moved to approve the minutes from the March 24, 2020 and April 21, 2020 County Board meetings. Supervisor Johnson seconded the motion. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote.

<u>Ordinance 175-O-009</u>: Authorize Acceptance Of And Appropriate Additional Wisconsin Department Of Corrections Windows To Work Grant Funds For Re-Entry Workforce Development Services In Waukesha, Ozaukee, And Washington Counties And Amend The 2020 Budget

Supervisor Grant moved to adopt Ordinance 175-O-009. Supervisor Dondlinger seconded the motion. The Board was poll and twenty-five (25) votes were cast 'aye'. The Ordinance was adopted.

Executive Committee

Appointment 175-A-001: Mary Berg to the Health & Human Services Board Appointment 175-A-002: Christine Howard to the Health & Human Services Board

Supervisor Heinrich moved approval of Appointments 175-A-001 and 175-A-002. Supervisor Swan seconded the motion. The Board was polled and twenty-five (25) votes were cast 'aye'. The appointments were confirmed.

Ordinance 175-O-013: Amend Waukesha County Board Of Supervisors' Operating Procedures And Rules By Amending The Text Of The Code Of Ordinances, Chapter 4

Supervisor Heinrich moved approval of Ordinance 175-O-013 Amend Waukesha County Board of Supervisors' Operating Procedures And Rules by Amending The Text of The Code of Ordinances, Chapter 4. Supervisor Wolff seconded the motion. The Board was polled on the amended motion and twenty-one (21) votes were cast 'aye' and four (4) votes were cast 'nay' (Grant, Hammitt, Whittow, Johnson). The Ordinance passed as amended.

Supervisor Heinrich moved Amendment #1 to Ordinance 175-O-013. Supervisor Dondlinger seconded the motion. The Board was polled and twenty (20) votes were cast 'aye' and five (5) votes were cast 'nay' (Grant, Cummings, Hammitt, Whittow, Johnson). Amendment #1 passed.

Supervisor Whittow moved to indefinitely postpone action on the Ordinance. Supervisor Johnson seconded the motion. The Board was polled and twelve (12) votes were cast 'aye' (Foti, Morris, Batzko, Grant, Swan, Decker, Mommaerts, Crowley, Cummings, Hammitt, Whittow, Johnson) and thirteen (13) votes were cast 'nay' (Zimmermann, Dondlinger, Walz, Michalski, Heinrich, Howard, Wolff, Mitchell, Paulson, Nelson, Schellinger, Gaughan, Wysocki), the motion failed.

Supervisor Zimmermann moved Amendment #2 to Ordinance 175-O-013. Supervisor Walz seconded the motion. The Board was polled and twenty-one (21) votes were cast 'aye' and four (4) votes were cast 'nay' (Decker, Gaughan, Whittow, Johnson). Amendment #2 passed as amended.

The Board was polled and fifteen (15) votes were cast 'aye' (Foti, Morris, Dondlinger, Walz, Grant, Michalski, Mommaerts, Mitchell, Crowley, Cummings, Schellinger, Wysocki, Hammitt, Whittow, Johnson) and ten (10) votes were cast 'nay' (Zimmermann, Batzko, Heinrich, Swan, Howard, Wolff, Decker, Paulson, Nelson, Gaughan). The amendment to Amendment #2 passed.

The Board was polled and fifteen (15) votes were cast 'aye' (Zimmerman, Morris, Batzko, Dondlinger, Grant, Michalski, Mommaerts, Mitchell, Crowley, Paulson, Cummings, Wysocki, Hammitt, Whittow, Johnson and ten (10) votes were cast 'nay' (Foti, Walz, Heinrich, Swan, Howard, Wolff, Decker, Nelson, Schellinger, Gaughan). Amendment #3 passed.

The Board was polled and eighteen (18) votes were cast 'aye' (Foti, Zimmermann, Morris, Batzko, Walz, Michalski, Heinrich, Howard, Wolff, Decker, Mommaerts, Crowley, Paulson, Nelson, Schellinger, Hammitt, Whittow, Johnson) and seven (7) votes were cast 'nay' Dondlinger, Grant, Swan, Mitchell, Cummings, Gaughan, Wysocki). The motion to Call the Question passed.
