5. Approval of July 20, 2017 & August 17, 2017 Meeting Minutes

K. Carr moved to approve the minutes from the July 20, 2017 LLBMD meeting as presented. T. Largent seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

K. Carr moved to approve the minutes from the August 17, 2017 LLBMD Organizational Meeting as presented. T. Largent seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

6. Review 2017 Annual Meeting Minutes

The Draft 2017 Annual Meeting Minutes were reviewed.

7. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report for October 19, 2017 was distributed to Commissioners with balances and pending checks noted. All accounts and payment authorizations were reviewed.

D. Bauer moved to Item 14 and 15 on the agenda at this time.

K. Carr moved to approve the Treasurer's Report for October 19, 2017 as presented. T. Largent seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

a. Update on Consolidation of Accounts

Commissioners discussed consolidation of the current banking accounts.

K. Carr moved to consolidate bank accounts into a checking account and money market account to be held at a local bank. T. Largent seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

8. Payment Authorizations

Payment authorizations were reviewed. A payment authorization to Thoroughbred Design Group in the amount of \$199.00 had been inadvertently left off the list of authorizations for this meeting. As a result of discussions pertaining to Items 14 and 15 on the agenda held earlier in this meeting, there was a \$100.00 Annual Membership Fee for the Clean Water Association and an expenditure, not to exceed \$250, for sponsorship of the Wisconsin Wetlands Association -Wetland Science Conference that would be added to the payment authorization list for this meeting.

K. Carr moved to approve the Payment Authorizations, including Thoroughbred Design Group in the amount of \$199.00, Clean Water Association in the amount of \$100.00 and the reimbursement to the Vande Zandes for the 2017 Shoreland Restoration Program in the amount of \$759.95, as presented. T. Largent seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

10. Update on Starry Stonewort Signage at Boat Launch

Information had been requested from City Staff regarding placement of Starry Stonewort signage at the City Beach boat launch. A response had not yet been received.

13. Update on Noise/Light Ordinances From Surrounding Municipalities

Discussion ensued regarding noise/ light ordinances in surrounding municipalities. Noise ordinances were in place that required motors to operate at certain decibels. These ordinances were in place as a result of state law. Enforcement of the law was an issue. Nuisance from noise

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and light were considered issues primarily in the summer months. Discussion ensued. No action was taken.

14. Update on Lake Country Community Board Meeting

D. Bauer explained Karen Trepton had attended the most recent Lake Country Community Board quarterly meeting. Information was distributed to the Commissioners regarding topics discussed at that meeting, including a Field Technology day event that demonstrated the use of aerial seeding. It was noted that Muskego Lake had recently conducted a drawdown of the lake to thwart the growth of Starry Stonewort.

a. Discuss & Act on \$100.00 Annual Membership Fee

K. Carr moved to pay the \$100.00 Annual Membership Fee for the Clean Water Association. L. Morgan seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

b. <u>Discuss & Act on Sponsorship at the 2018 Wetlands Science Conference at Olympia Resort</u>

It was also noted that the Wisconsin Wetlands Association -Wetland Science Conference was being held February 20-22, 2018 at the Olympia Resort in Oconomowoc, WI. All were invited to attend. Sponsorship opportunities were provided for this event. Discussion ensued regarding the benefits of sponsorship in this event.

K. Carr moved to authorize an expenditure, not to exceed \$250, for sponsorship of the Wisconsin Wetlands Association -Wetland Science Conference that was being held February 20-22, 2018 at the Olympia Resort in Oconomowoc, WI. T. Largent seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

c. Discuss & Act on 2017 Representative for Lake Country Community Board Meetings

15. Discuss & Act on Completion of 2017 Shoreland Restoration Program

K. Carr explained planting at the Vande Zande shoreline had been completed since the last meeting. L. Morgan noted a payment request for \$759.95 had been submitted for reimbursement of the Vande Zande project as part of the 2017 Shoreland Restoration Program. Lisa Reas had not yet provided an invoice to the District for the 2017 program. Payment of the outstanding invoice would be required prior to the next LLBMD meeting.

K. Carr moved to pay the invoice from Lisa Reas if it arrived prior to March, 2018 for an amount not to exceed \$1,000, subject to verification of completion of the 2017 Shoreland

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Restoration Program. L. Morgan seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

D. Bauer returned to Item 7 and the remainder of the agenda at this time.
