

COUNTY BOARD PROCEEDINGS 13th Meeting, 171st Year of the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors Tuesday, March 28, 2017

CONVENE MEETING

<u>Call to Order</u>: Chairman Decker called the meeting to order and led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

Roll Call: County Board Supervisors Michalski, Grant and Zimmermann notified they would not be in attendance. All other County Board Supervisors were present.

<u>Approve Minutes of Previous Meeting</u>s: Supervisor Wysocki moved to approve the minutes from the January 24, 2017 County Board Meeting. Supervisor Howard seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved by voice vote.
