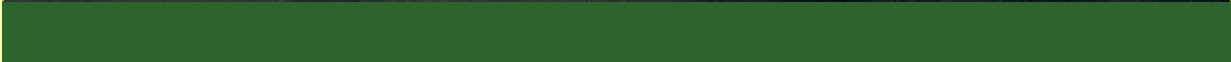
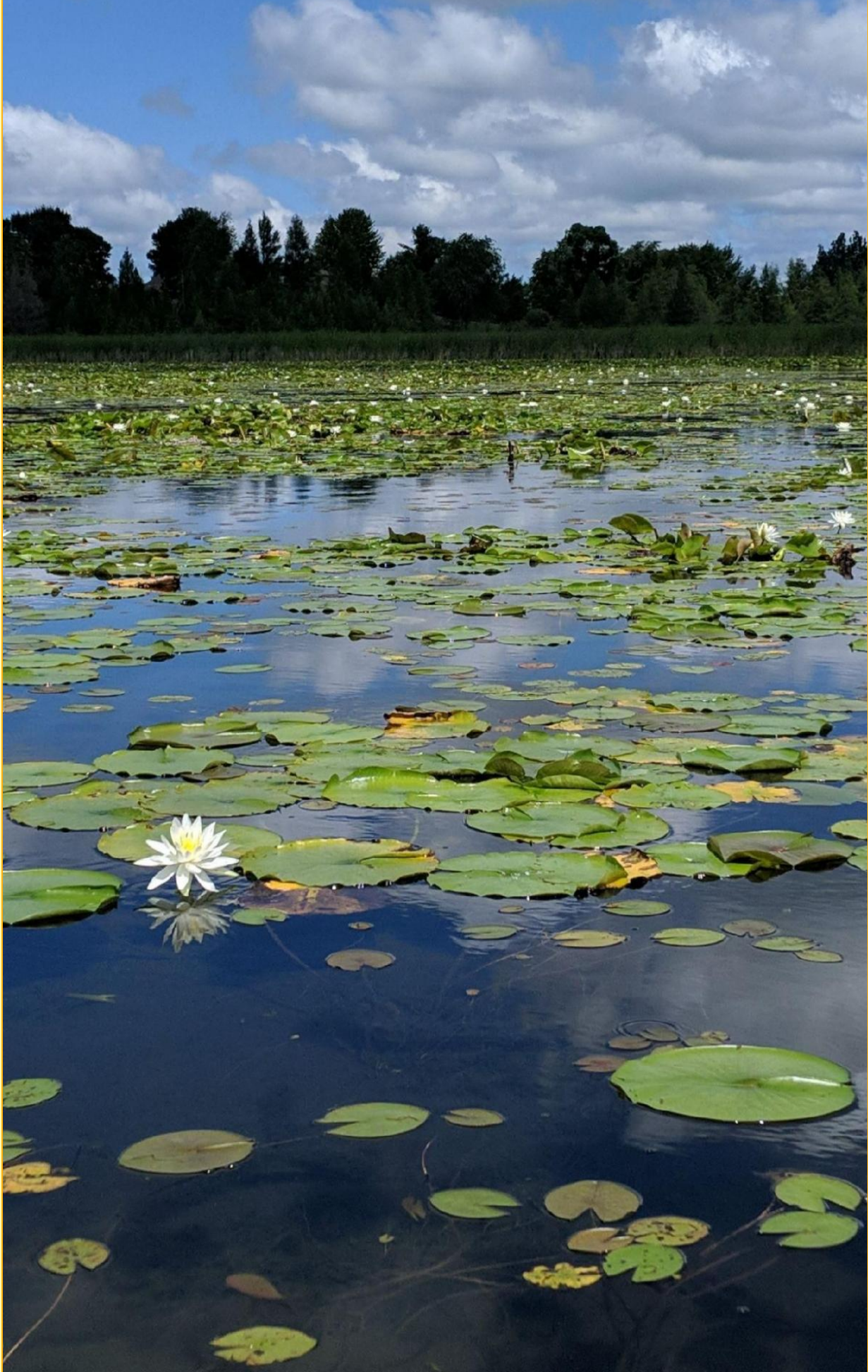


Boating season has arrived! Make sure that you're familiar with Wisconsin boating laws, aquatic invasive species (and their prevention), and how to keep our waterways healthy.
