Review Revisions to Restitution Affidavit Form & Discuss Start Date for Pilot

Fries distributed and reviewed two drafts of the Affidavit of Restitution.

The workgroup discussed changes to the form, which included removing the paragraph containing the explanation of the form and instructions on how to complete it properly. That information will be placed on a separate cover page attachment. This allows the form to read like a typical affidavit. Aprahamian stated that the affidavit needs to be notarized, as it is being submitted as testimony to the court.

Dunn will develop the cover page, and Fries will update the affidavit. Both documents will be sent to the workgroup for review when completed.

Luczaj stated that other WI EBDM counties are interested in our Restitution Affidavit pilot, and may want to replicate it, if successful.
