Spaeth said Executive committee discussed ordinances that passed at the December County Board meeting.

Discussed and Considered Ordinance 171-O-072: Delegation Of Authority To Approve Functional Executive Classification Changes For Highways In Rural Areas

Evans said this ordinance will continue the practice of delegating authority to the Director of Public Works to approve Highway Functional Classification changes for highways in rural areas. Swan asked for clarification on the definitions of arterial and collector roads and Evans provided examples to the committee. (Hammitt arrived at 6:25 p.m.) Paulson was recognized and asked the committee not to support the ordinance, as he believes it chips away at the board's authority.

Swan and Evans discussed a presentation that was given by Public Works Director Bussler regarding legislation that would allow locals to swap federal funds with state funds to complete local road projects. Committee members were emailed copies of the presentation.
