Discuss and Consider Bid to Replace Building Automation Systems (BAS) for the Mental Health Complex, Highway Operations building, and the Employee Health & Wellness Center Ramos said the Building Automation Systems (BAS) for the Mental Health Complex, Highway Operations building, and the Employee Health & Wellness Center are aging, parts are hard to come by and the software is no longer supported. The department bid out the work to replace the BAS. Only the supervisory controller is to be replaced, leaving the various field controllers intact. Three bids were received and the lowest responsible bidder was CBRE ESI with a bid of \$32,271.84. CBRE ESI stated they understand the scope of the project and are able to successfully complete it on time.

Discuss and Consider Bid for Mukwonago Park Shower Facility Restroom Addition – Project #PLU23-04

Siodlarz presented that three bids were received for this project and the recommendation is to award the contract to the lowest bidder, Gilbank Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$116,531.00. Gilbank Construction, Inc. has stated that they can complete the work within the County's schedule, has completed the non-collusion affidavit, and has demonstrated sufficient qualifications and responsibility for this project.
