Dorow called the meeting to order at 12:20 p.m.

Presentation: Drug Testing as a Condition of Bail

Dorow shared a video titled "Conditions of Pretrial Release." Hankey reviewed a PowerPoint presentation regarding best practices for pretrial release conditions. Luczaj distributed a document titled "Pretrial Drug Testing."

Hankey posed the following question to the group for consideration: "What are we trying to achieve with drug testing as a condition of bail?" She then reviewed the 4 key findings from research compiled by Advancing Pretrial Policy & Research, which include:

- 1) There is no clear association between drug testing and improved pretrial outcomes
- 2) The impact of noncompliance with drug testing on the likelihood of pretrial failure is uncertain
- 3) Cost-benefit considerations must be made
- 4) Drug testing can lead to poorer pretrial outcomes among people assessed as more likely to succeed

Hankey told the group that we need to know what our own data is telling us. Luczaj proposed a 6-month data collection pilot to collect and analyze local data surrounding our use of drug testing as a condition of bail. The group will discuss this further at the next meeting.
