Advisory and Standing Committee Reports

- Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC)Advisory Board Committee
 - As part of the ADRC's annual organizational plan, one goal is to increase engagement with the Hispanic Community. The ADRC is working closing with the Hispanic Resource Center.
 - Bittman attended the Elder Justice/Adult Protective Services (APS) Conference.
 The conference allowed attendees to hear best practices as well as share concerns and issues that they experience.
 - The ADRC has a site manager for La Casa's restaurant, and it will open for senior dining on November 1.
 - The ADRC provided copies of the October 2022 newsletter and the brochure for the list of meal sites.
- Public Health Advisory Committee
 - Community Health Improvement Plan and Process (CHIPP) committees continue efforts on finalizing priorities and assigning upstream factors that influence health.
 The priorities have been identified as substance use, mental health and healthy aging which includes social determinants of health and social connectedness.
 - Public Health is encouraging staff and clients to receive flu shots and COVID vaccine booster.
- No update was available on the Mental Health Advisory Committee (MHAC). Dallmann-Papke will be requesting permission to attend the next meeting in person.
- The Substance Use Advisory Committee (SUAC)has not met since the last board meeting.

Community Health Update – Fentanyl

Aldred provided an update regarding the community health initiative regarding Waukesha County Health Crisis on Fentanyl. Currently, the Community Health Initiative Squad is in the data collection process. Goldstone informed the group that Fentanyl test strips are not 100% accurate. Positive is positive; however, there are many forms of Fentanyl and not all negative test results are negative.

Admin Services Division Presentation

Setzer reviewed a presentation titled "Overview of Administrative Services Mandated Services."

Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Update

Yauchler provided an update regarding the survey from Department of Health Services (DHS) Division of Quality Assurance (DQA), in response to a complaint about a former employee that MHC did not report. MHC received a statement of deficiency related to this review and completed a plan of action to address the issue.

At the end of August, MHC received an unannounced survey from WIS DHS representing CMS. These surveys are deficiency driven which means the survey team is looking for areas of deficiency. MHC was sited in seven areas; many were related to documentation.
