CONVENE MEETING

Call to Order: Vice Chairman Heinrich called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer.

Supervisors Crowley and Decker notified the Vice Chairman that they would be absent.

Public Comment: James Pfefferle spoke against the proposed rebuild of the Hwy F and Lindsay Road project included in the Five-Year Capital Projects Plan

County Clerk Correspondence & Announcements: County Clerk Wartman announced that County Executive Farrow signed all ordinances from the September 22, 2020 board meeting and that two claims had been filed since the September Board Meeting.

Approval of the minutes: Supervisor Johnson moved to approve the minutes from the September 22, 2020 County Board meeting. Supervisor Cummings seconded the motion. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote.

Supervisor Cummings was recognized and requested that Project number 26 of the Capital Projects Plan be considered separately. The Board was polled and twenty-three (23) votes were cast 'aye'. The Resolution, minus the Project 26, was passed unanimously.

The Board was polled on including Project 26, of the Five Year Capital Plan and fifteen (15) votes were cast 'aye' (Foti, Zimmermann, Morris, Dondlinger, Heinrich, Swan, Howard, Wolff, Paulson, Nelson, Schellinger, Gaugan, Wysocki, Hammitt, Whittow) while eight (8) votes were cast 'nay' (Batzko, Walz, Grant, Michalski, Mommaerts, Mitchell, Cummings, Johnson). The inclusion of Project 26 of the Five-Year Capital Plan was approved.
