
Project Background

The Waukesha County Department of Public Works is in the design phase for the pavement replacement of 1.4-miles of County O (Moorland Road) to improve ride quality and safety along the corridor. Improvements will include: replacing the existing concrete pavement, reconfiguring intersections to improve safety, replacing traffc signals, minor grading, and storm water improvements.

The first public involvement meeting was held virtually on November 11, 2020. Three alternatives were presented at the meeting that accommodated a sidewalk within the Waukesha County ultimate right-of-way plan width of 130'.

Selection of Preferred Alternative

In collaboration with the City of New Berlin, a decision has been made NOT to include sidewalk as part of the recommended improvement. The median curb lines will move inward 2' to accommodate parking and bicycles within the revised pavement footprint. The outside curb line will generally be replaced in the same location that it exists today.



Real Estate Impacts

Temporary easements to accommodate grading and driveway replacement will be needed along the corridor, fee acquisition is limited to intersection improvement locations and where the existing right-of-way is narrower than the typical corridor width and is shown on the exhibits and displays at this meeting.

Traffic Impacts During Construction

Waukesha County is committed to keeping the roadway open for travel in both direction during construction on both Moorland Road and National Avenue. The proposed traffic control plan for the project calls for maintaining one lane in each direction during all phases of construction. The project will be constructed in two primary phases outlined as follows:

- In Stage 1, bidirectional traffic will travel on the existing southbound Moorland Road roadway while the new northbound lanes are constructed. Access to properties will be maintained through a Two-Way-Left-Turn-Lane (TWLTL) or at a median opening between the two travel lanes.
- In Stage 2, bidirectional traffic will travel on the newly constructed northbound Moorland Road roadway while the new southbound lanes are constructed. Access to properties will be maintained through a TWLTL or at a median opening similar to stage 1.








PROPOSED MOORLAND ROAD BUILD

W. HOWARD AVENUE TO W. NATIONAL AVENUE STA 82+89 - STA 99+67








The Waukesha County Department of Public Works is in the design phase for the pavement replacement of 1.4-miles of County O (Moorland Road) to improve ride quality and safety along the corridor. Improvements will include: replacing the existing concrete pavement, reconfiguring intersections to improve safety, replacing traffic signals, minor grading, and storm water improvements.

The first public involvement meeting was held virtually on November 11, 2020. Three alternatives were presented at the meeting that accommodated a sidewalk within the Waukesha County ultimate right-of-way plan width of 130'. In collaboration with the City, a decision has been made NOT to include sidewalk as part of the recommended improvement. The median curb lines will move inward 2' to accommodate parking and bicycles within the revised pavement footprint. The outside curb line will generally be replaced in the same location that it exists today.

You are invited to attend an in person Public Involvement Meeting to present the preferred alternative for the County O project. The meeting will be held in an open house format and attendees will be required to follow current CDC quidance and wear a face mask if they have not been vaccinated. The meeting will be held from 4:30-6:30 in the Council Chambers at the New Berlin City Hall located at 3805 Casper Drive, New Berlin, WI 53151. Design staff will be on hand to answer your questions and discuss your individual concerns.

Traffic Impacts During Construction

Waukesha County is committed to keeping the roadway open for travel in both directions during construction on both Moorland Road and National Avenue. Construction is currently planned for 2023 and it is anticipated to require the entire construction season from April to November to complete project.

You're Invited: Virtual Pubic Meeting via Zoom - 5:30 pm on November 12, 2020

The Waukesha County Department of Public Works is in the planning phase for the pavement replacement of 1.4-miles of CTH O (Moorland Road) to bring it up to current standards. Improvements will include: replacing the existing concrete pavement, reconfiguring intersections to improve safety, replacing older traffic signals, minor grading, and storm water improvements. The feasibility for incorporating sidewalks will also be evaluated.

The focus of this meeting will be to hear the community's input regarding roadway design alternatives. The alternatives being presented were developed using design criteria required by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for use on projects that will utilize federal funding. We are looking for feedback from the project stakeholders on design elements including sidewalks, access modifications, and right-of-way/construction impacts.

The meeting will be held via Zoom on November 12, 2020 with a presentation starting at 5:30 pm that will allow participants to submit questions through a chat window during the meeting. 

Study Alternatives

The project will study the feasibility of adding bicycle and pedestrian accommodations to one or both sides of the roadway. Alternatives will consider moving curb lines to allow for the inclusion of parking, bicycle accommodations and sidewalk. Strip takings of right-of-way acquisition are anticipated to accommodate the proposed sidewalk location.




