Wanted Subject

On Thursday, November 18, 2021, at 10:10 am, a Waukesha County Sheriff's Deputy was checking a residence at 875 Crescent Lane in the Village of Hartland for a subject wanted on several warrants through the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office. The deputy observed the subject who was identified as Chad Fowler at the residence. Fowler was wanted for the following offenses:
