Waukesha County Sheriff's Department Cadet Unit 6700

Thank you for your interest in our Cadet Unit. Our Cadet Unit typically meets every Sunday evening from 7-9pm at the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department. We present topics related to upcoming competitions, or general info about the Sheriff's Department procedures, personnel, specialty teams, policies, etc. There is a group of Mentors for the unit, with a variety of backgrounds and expertise.

Cost:

The annual cost is \$15 which is to register each cadet with <u>PSC</u> who provide insurance for our program.

Uniform:

There is also a one-time \$40 charge for the class B uniform (polo shirt). Cadets will be provided a class A dress uniform once they have completed the probationary period. Cadets mostly wear the class B uniforms which is the black polo shirt, and BDU or cargo style pants. Black boots or shoes are also required.

Volunteer Opportunities:

Per calendar year, there is a 24 hour volunteer requirement. There are many opportunities, including the County Fair, Sussex Lions Daze, roll playing for department training, and Shop with a Sheriff.

Training:

We host scenario-based training which is a great learning experience. Typical topics for the scenario training include traffic stops, burglary, evidence collection, shoot/don't shoot use of force decision making, crisis negotiations, conflict resolution, domestic violence, and operating while under the influence arrests. We also enter our Cadet Unit into several competitions around the state to enhance their training and allow them to network with other Cadet Units.

Application:

The first step in the process is a background check. If you are interested in joining the Unit, please complete the application on the second page. By signing the bottom, it indicates you understand and allow the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department to complete a background check. Note: if you are under 18 years old, a parent or guardian must also sign this form.

Once the background check is complete, you will be contacted by email. If approved we will schedule a time for you to come in for an orientation. Usually this is done just prior to one of our scheduled meetings. If you are under 18, a parent or guardian must attend to sign the paperwork. If you would prefer to observe a meeting before joining our Unit that can easily be arranged.
