Order of the Purple Heart (MOPH), did receive an increase. Mr. Johannes explained that we did not receive an increase. We did receive the maximum grant allowed County Veterans Service Offices (CVSO), \$13,000. The WDVA grant to CVSO's is based on veteran population.
