

**AODA ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING  
JANUARY 19, 2010  
MINUTES**

**PRESENT:** Susan Andrews, Lou Hernandez, Dennis Williams, Lee Wipfli, Rose Barton, Dick Manke, James Pearson

The meeting was called to order at 10:04 am.

**INTRODUCTIONS OF MEMBERS AND GUESTS**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The minutes of the November 17, 2009 meeting were approved as read.

**PRESENTATION**

Bernie Juno, Executive Director of Hebron House of Hospitality gave the Committee an update on the emergency homeless shelter. She handed out statistics. They have helped 91 unduplicated individuals from November 15, 2009 to January 13, 2010. 71% are from Waukesha County and 93% have lived in Wisconsin for five years or more. 52% have a high school degree or higher education. She also talked about finding a permanent solution to lack of adequate housing. Hebron House of Hospitality is looking to open a 10-unit facility with HUD Housing. They already have a 16-unit facility for individuals with Dual Diagnosis Issues, and they hope to find a permanent place for a men's shelter with support services available. Discussion followed.

**PRESENTATION**

Mike DeMares, Manager Clinical Services Division for Waukesha County discussed the changes to Substance Abuse Services in Waukesha County in the last year. Lawrence Center closed in June of 2009 and Alcohol Detox Services moved to the Community Hospitals. The Opiate Outpatient Program using Suboxone. There is limited Opiate Detox available at the Mental Health Center. House of Hope closed on January 11, 2010. Women's half way house services remain available outside of the County. We have a lot of individuals and their families calling for Suboxone medication, but the County does not prescribe that at this time. The residents are being told how to access that medication as a private pay in the community. Discussion followed.

Dick Manke suggests continued support for the Alcohol Court as an unmet need.

Lee Wipfli will ask someone from the Needle Exchange Program to come and speak in February. Rose Barton will invite someone from WCS to speak on the Day Report Program also in February so the committee can discuss and finalize the unmet needs.

**COUNTY AODA LIAISON REPORT**

Rose Barton made a motion, seconded by Lee Wipfli, to adjourn the meeting. The motion was voted on and passed.
