

**AODA ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING
JUNE 15, 2010

INTRODUCTION OF MEMBERS AND GUEST

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the May 18, 2010 meeting were approved as read.

PRESENTATION

Sandy Lybert from Your Choice presented. She handed out brochures and gave some background information on Your Choice, a program that is directed at youth and their families. The presentation has been given at the schools in an effort to prevent alcohol and drug abuse. The presentation is currently for 6, 7, and 8 graders; however, they are considering the possibility of presenting in high schools. The program also includes a parent component. It is an informative program to educate kids regarding dangers of drug and alcohol abuse. Presenters are mainly young people who talk about their experiences with substances and the negative impact of their use. Discussion followed.

Rebecca Luczaj from the Criminal Justice Collaborating Council presented. The Council began looking at jail over crowding in 2002. The Council meets every other month and the Executive committee meets every month. The Council provides oversight for various adult programs in the county. Recent initiatives such as expanding Alcohol Treatment Court. They have applied for a grant to expand the program to include fourth OWI's and eliminate the waiting list currently of people with three OWI's, and are working on expanding the Day Reporting Center. Discussion followed. It was proposed that Rebecca Luczaj provide information from their committee meetings to Susan Andrews or acting Chairman so that the Advisory Committee is updated on current progress with any changes that occur.

CITIZEN MEMBER REPORT

Mike O'Brien stated that his committee of unmet needs is working on similar issues that the CJCC is working on.

COUNTY AODA LIAISON REPORT

Susan Andrews reported that they have filled the job opening that was left by Scott Ashley's retirement. The new hire is Lori McIlroy, she will be starting on June 21, 2010.
