**VETERANS SERVICE COMMISSION MINUTES
EMERGENCY MEETING: June 14, 2010**

It was noted that Mr. James Kebisek's name was spelled incorrectly and Mr. Thomas Ludka's initials were incorrect. There were no other corrections to the minutes. Mr. James Kebisek made a motion to accept the minutes. Mr. Thomas Ludka seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

This male veteran was in the Army from 1963 to 1967. He is in a HUD-VASH approved program. He is looking to move from Waukesha to Pewaukee and is asking for assistance with the rent, security deposit and move. HUD-VASH will pay the first month's rent in full but cannot provide the security deposit.

Mr. Ludka recommended the Commission approve the security deposit of \$595:

Vet will pay partial rent while he is in the HUD-VASH Program. Mr. Stoel offered to supply a trailer and vehicle if the vet can supply the manpower to move him.

A homeless veteran's situation was discussed.


The HUD-VASH Program was discussed. The program provides case management and community support services to keep veteran families in safe and decent housing in the community.
