In 1935, just 32 years after the Wright Brothers' famous first flight, Waukesha County Airport began as an airport for aviation enthusiasts to learn to fly. Today, the airport serves a variety of business and recreational flight, providing nearly 1,000 jobs that generate over \$24 million in wages and payroll per year for the local community, according to a 2009 economic impact report. The airport is also credited with generating nearly \$81 million in sales for the organizations that use it for aviation, and the companies that provide goods and services to them.
