### SPECIAL SPRING HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTIONS

Waukesha, WIS – County residents can participate in special one-day household hazardous waste (HHW) collection opportunities from 8 a.m. until 12 p.m. at the following municipalities:

- **Saturday, May 21 – Mukwonago at the Village Public Works Garage, 630 Hwy NN**
- **Saturday, June 4 – Brookfield at the City Public Works Yard, 19450 Riverview Drive**
- **Saturday, June 18 – Delafield at the Department of Public Works, 111 Main Street**

“Old, unusable chemicals, pesticides, wood preservatives, solvents, oil-based paints, and mercury-containing products will be accepted from residents”, stated Karen Fielder, the County’s Recycling Supervisor. “Latex paint and non-hazardous cleaning materials will not be accepted,” she added.

In addition to these special HHW collection dates, these sites provide year-round collection services:

- **Waukesha site:**

- **Menomonee Falls site:**  
Onyx Environmental Services

Hours: Every Monday and Wednesday 11 a.m.- 6 p.m.  
Saturdays 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. (except holidays).  
**Closed Saturday, May 28 and Monday, May 30 for Memorial Day.**
- **Muskego site:**  
Jensen Environmental Management  
W144 S6347 College Court [south of W. College Ave. (HH), west of Sunnyslope  
Hours: Saturdays 8 a.m. to noon (except holiday weekends). **Closed Saturday, May 28.**
