IMMUNIZATION CLINIC RELOCATION
Serving Public Needs More Efficiently

Waukesha, WIS. – As of June 15, Waukesha County's Public Health Division will offer an Immunization Clinic at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church on the third Wednesday of each month from 4-6 p.m.

The clinic, formerly held at La Casa de Esperanza, was relocated after May 18 due to space constraints at the agency. Individuals are encouraged to attend the new location.

Immunizations and TB Skin Tests for children and adults will be offered. Children can receive immunizations for \$6.50 fee, which can be waived. Adult vaccine fees range in cost from \$6.50 to \$74 and will not be waived. A Spanish interpreter will be available. Attendees must follow these instructions to participate:

- All Immunization Records **MUST** be brought to each clinic
- Parent or legal guardian **MUST** sign for children being immunized
