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**Installation of Traffic Signal to Improve Traffic Flow
C.T.H. "TT"/Meadowbrook and Northview**

Waukesha, WIS. – Waukesha County's Department of Public Works awarded a contract to Payne & Dolan Inc. for the installation of a traffic signal and turn lanes at the intersection of County Trunk Highway (C.T.H.) "TT"/Meadowbrook Rd. and Northview Rd. in the city of Waukesha.

Work is expected to begin on Mon., Oct. 3 and will last approximately six weeks.

Currently, over 15,000 vehicles pass through the intersection daily, which is controlled by 4-way stop signs. Due to the heavy traffic volume, long backups occur during rush hours. The department expects that this project will eliminate existing motorist delays.

The City Council and the County Board agreed to modify speed limits when the signal is operational. The city speed limit will be raised from 25 mph to 35 mph on Meadowbrook Rd. The county speed limit will be lowered from 55 mph to 45 mph on C.T.H. "TT".
