Public Information Meeting for C.T.H. X Improvement Project

Waukesha, WIS. – Waukesha County will hold the first public information meeting for the County Trunk Highway (C.T.H.) X (Genesee Rd.) improvement project on Thursday, June 1 at the Waukesha Town Hall from 4 – 7 p.m. The purpose of the meeting, which will be held in an open house format, is to provide the public with information regarding the scope of work, various alternatives and schedule of activities.

The project, scheduled for construction in 2008, will begin at State Trunk Highway (S.T.H.) 59 on the south end and will extend approximately two miles northeast to Harris Highland Dr., all in the city and town of Waukesha. It will include the development and evaluation of alternatives that will expand C.T.H. X to a 4-lane divided roadway. The bridge over Pebble Creek will be replaced and the bridge over the railroad and bike trail will be widened.

The Waukesha Town Hall is located at W250 S3567 Center Rd. Representatives from the county's Department of Public Works, the consultant, Kapur & Associates, and local public officials will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.
