**Rehabilitation Work on C.T.H. "K" – Village of Menomonee Falls**

Waukesha, WIS. – Waukesha County plans to rehabilitate County Trunk Highway (C.T.H.) "K" in the Village of Menomonee Falls from C.T.H. "Y" (Lannon Road) to the Brookfield city limits.

Construction activities are scheduled to begin September 20 with the road closed to through traffic for approximately one week. A detour route will be posted to instruct drivers to take C.T.H. "Y" (Lannon Road) to C.T.H. "VV" (Silver Spring Road) to C.T.H. "YY" (Pilgrim Road).

Emergency vehicles and local residents will be able to access all properties within the construction area.

The project includes the crushing and relaying of the existing pavement and placing new asphalt pavement and the replacement of the shoulders. The work will be done in conjunction with the paving of a right turn lane on southbound Lannon Road and culvert replacement at the Brookfield Road intersection.
