IMMUNIZATION CLINICS OFFERED

Waukesha, WIS. – Waukesha County’s Public Health Division will offer childhood and adult immunization clinics at a variety of times and locations throughout the community.

Children can receive immunizations for a \$7.00 fee, which may be waived. Adult vaccine fees range in cost from \$7.00 to \$105.00 and will not be waived.

Other services offered at the immunization clinics include TB skin tests for persons age one through adult (except at Thursday clinics) and lead screenings for children one to five years of age.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- All Immunization Records **MUST** be brought to each clinic
- Parent or legal guardian **MUST** sign for children being immunized
