**SPECIAL STUDENT IMMUNIZATION CLINICS**

Waukesha, WIS. – Waukesha County’s Public Health Division will hold special student immunization clinics for students entering 6th, 9th and 12th grades in the Fall of 2008. (Special clinics limited to students in these grades.) These clinics will immunize for Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) and Varicella (chickenpox) vaccines. (No other vaccines available.)

New student immunization requirements will be in effect in the Fall of 2008. For more information about the new vaccine requirements and waivers, call your school or the Waukesha County Public Health Division at (262) 896-8430 or visit the website [www.waukeshacounty.gov/publichealth](http://www.waukeshacounty.gov/publichealth) . Only children entering the specified grades can receive Tdap and Varicella immunizations for a cost of \$7.00 each, which may be waived if necessary. There is no fee for children on Medicaid (Title 19).
