The winners will be honored at the fifteenth County Executive Awards Luncheon at the Country Springs, Waukesha, on Thursday, October 14. Registration will start at 11:30 a.m., followed by lunch at 12 p.m.

Keith Tozer, the Head Coach and Vice President of Soccer Operations for the Milwaukee Wave, will be the keynote speaker and his address will focus on leadership and building a winning team. He has spent 26 years coaching indoor soccer, 18 with the Milwaukee Wave, and compiled more victories than any other coach in North American indoor soccer history. This year, Tozer was named Major Indoor Soccer League “Coach of the Year” for a record eighth time. Along the way Tozer has won eight regular season championships with the Wave and four league championships. He has also coached nine All-Star teams, more than any other coach in professional indoor soccer history.

In 2005, Tozer created Teamwork Concepts, a motivational speaking company focused on Tozer’s tradition of service and giving back to the community in order to encourage motivation, leadership and communication in the workplace. Through his speeches, Tozer takes his coaching and leadership legacy from the soccer field to the boardroom.
