WAUKESHA COUNTY PARTNERING WITH CITY OF DELAFIELD ON ROAD PROJECT

WAUKESHA, Wis. – Waukesha County Executive Dan Vrakas announced today that Waukesha County is partnering with the City of Delafield to rehabilitate County Trunk Highway C (Genesee Street) between Mill Street and Oakwood Road located in the southwest quadrant of the City. The plans will be included in Waukesha County Executive Dan Vrakas’ 2011 – 2015 Five Year Capital Plan, a significant portion of the Executive’s proposed 2011 budget.

Plans include repaving a portion of CTH C and adding curbs, gutters and sidewalks. Once the upgrades are complete, jurisdiction of the road will be transferred from the County to the City. The road, last resurfaced in 1996, is in need of resurfacing, which will be included as part of this project.

“The City of Delafield is excited that Waukesha County is including this project in the 2011-2015 Capital Plans,” said Delafield Mayor Ed McAleer.

The City of Delafield’s share of the project is approximately 27% of the total project cost and covers the design and construction of the City requested amenities such as sidewalks, storm sewers, bypass lanes, landscaping and street lights.

“This project is an example of an outstanding partnership between the County and our municipalities,” Vrakas said. “When we work together great things can be accomplished.”

The Capital Plan portion of the budget will be introduced to the County Board of Supervisors on September 1st. The County Board will review Vrakas’ full 2011 Budget in late September with final passage expected in November.
