WAUKESHA COUNTY TO HOLD FINAL H1N1 FLU MASS VACCINATION CLINIC

Vaccine to be provided at regularly scheduled immunization clinics

WAUKESHA, Wis. – The Waukesha County Division of Public Health will hold their final H1N1 mass vaccination clinic at White Rock Elementary School, located at 1150 White Rock Avenue in Waukesha on Monday, March 8th from 4 to 7 p.m. The clinic is intended to provide both the intranasal and injectable H1N1 vaccine, free of charge, to all Waukesha County residents on a first come, first serve basis.

Over the course of the last several months, Waukesha County Public Health has immunized over 15,000 individuals at their H1N1 vaccination clinics held at the Waukesha County Expo Center and various schools countywide. Monday's clinic will be the final H1N1 vaccination clinic of this type. In the future, the vaccine will be provided at routine immunization clinics held at various locations countywide. A schedule for the routine clinics can be found on the County website (www.waukeshacounty.gov/pandemicflu). Next year, the H1N1 vaccine will be included as part of the seasonal flu vaccine.

Consent and medical history forms that can be filled out in advance of the clinics are available on the Waukesha County website (www.waukeshacounty.gov/pandemicflu). It is recommended that those seeking the vaccine download and complete the form in advance of the clinic to expedite the vaccination process.
