IMPROVEMENTS TO COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY NN ANNOUNCED

Improvements affect Mukwonago portion of NN between 83 and ES

WAUKESHA, Wis. – County Executive Dan Vrakas announced plans today to rehabilitate CTH NN between State Highway 83 and CTH ES in Mukwonago, and to rehabilitate the CTH ES bridge over the Fox River, also located in Mukwonago, as part of the Executive’s 2010-2014 Five Year Capital Plan Budget.

The CTH NN improvement project will recondition the roadway with features such as better pavement quality, wider shoulders, improved intersection turn lanes and improved sight lines.

The current bridge over the Fox River is narrow with a substandard shoulder. The rehabilitation plan will increase the shoulder width and improve the bridge to meet current bridge standards. The project will also include a two-way bicycle trail addition.

“The rehabilitation of this bridge will improve the usability for residents,” Vrakas said. “The addition of the bicycle trail will allow bike riders to ride along the Fox River as part of the Parks and Land Use Department’s Bicycle Plan.”

The Capital Plan portion of the budget will be introduced to the County Board of Supervisors on September 1st. The County Board will review Vrakas’ full 2010 Budget in late September with final passage expected in November.
