HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PLANNED IN WAUKESHA COUNTY *County Trunk Highway Y (Barker Road) & CTH M (North Avenue)-Intersection*

Waukesha, WIS. – Wisconsin Department of Transportation and Waukesha County Department of Public Works plan the reconstruction of the County Trunk Highway (CTH) Y (Barker Road) and CTH M (North Avenue) Intersection, in the City of Brookfield. Construction will involve replacing the existing all-way stop controlled intersection with a multi-lane roundabout.

Barker Road will be open to traffic on a combination of existing and temporary lane configurations. North Avenue will be closed immediately east of Barker Road from June 15th until approximately July 4th, access to Elmbrook hospital on North Avenue will be from Brookfield Road. After July 4th, North Avenue east of Barker Road will be reopened, however, North Avenue, immediately west of Barker, will be closed for construction until late July. A detour route will be posted for both closures of North Avenue to route traffic to Springdale Road, to USH 18, and then Brookfield Road back to North Ave.

Construction activities are scheduled to begin the week of June 7, 2010 and are expected to be completed by August 13, 2010. During construction, to enhance the safety of the traveling public and construction crews, the speed limit will be reduced to 25 mph through the project limits.
