

Home Detention

Overview

Description: The Waukesha Home Detention program offers supervision and monitoring for juveniles who have committed crimes, are truant or are runaways/uncontrollable. By participating in this program offenders are allowed the opportunity to stay in their home, rather than at the Juvenile Detention Center, while awaiting the disposition of their case.

Started: 1977

Capacity: 18

Goals: The goal of the Waukesha Home Detention program is to help juvenile delinquents and status offenders stay in their homes rather than housing them in the Waukesha Juvenile Detention Center while providing them with opportunities to act within the law.

Incentives: The incentive of this program includes the ability to stay in the community.

Sanctions: A potential sanction of this program may be placement in non-secure detention in the Waukesha County Juvenile Center.
