

Intensive Tracking and Aftercare

Overview

Description: The Waukesha Intensive Tracking and Aftercare program provides supervision and monitoring for delinquent and status offenders in order to prevent them from being placed in an institution or other out of home placement. It also assists with the re-integration process of at-risk youth.

Started: 1990

Capacity: 30

Goals: The goal of this program is to divert juvenile delinquents and status offenders from institutional placement by providing intensive support and monitoring. Additionally, the goal is to assist juvenile offenders released from correctional placement with their reintegration back into the community.

Incentives: This program can help juveniles remain in the community and address problem areas that may cause their anti-social actions.

Sanctions: Not meeting the goals of this program may result in the juvenile being placed in detention or other out of home placement.
