8 WHEREAS Waukesha County currently participates in the Wisconsin Wildlife Damage
9 Abatement and Claims Program as authorized by Chapter 29 of Wisconsin Statutes, which is
10 funded by hunters around the state through sales of hunting licenses and bonus deer tags, and
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12 WHEREAS the program seeks to mitigate damage to crops and nursery stock from wildlife, and

14 WHEREAS state deer managers are encouraging hunters to help reduce the large deer herd in
15 many parts of the state, and

17 WHEREAS this year funds are available through this program to provide processed venison to
18 local food pantries, and

20 WHEREAS hunters may at no cost to themselves, donate extra deer harvested for processing,
21 and

23 WHEREAS this program promotes effective deer management provides additional hunting
24 opportunities, and worthwhile use of venison.

26 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES
27 ORDAIN that the Department of Parks and Land Use 2001 budget appropriation and
28 corresponding revenue be amended to accept additional funds from the Wildlife Damage
29 Abatement and Claims Program in the amount of \$12,000 for participation in the venison
30 processing program as approved by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

32 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Director of Parks and Land Use is authorized to execute
33 this program on behalf of the county.

FISCAL NOTE

DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND LAND USE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT DNR WILDLIFE DAMAGE FUNDS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE VENISON PROCESSING PROGRAM TO BENEFIT LOCAL FOOD PANTRIES

This ordinance authorizes the Department of Parks and Land Use to participate in a program to provide venison donated by hunters to area food pantries. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Wildlife Service would administer the program for the County. Hunters would donate deer carcasses to area meat processing plants approved by the USDA, and the finished venison would be distributed by the Food Pantry of Waukesha County.

The total cost of the program is capped at \$12,000; including \$10,800 for processing the donated venison at about \$60 per carcass (allowing for the processing of approximately 180 deer), and a \$1,200 administrative fee to the USDA Wildlife Service. The County would pay these charges and apply for reimbursement to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, which funds the program through the sale of hunting licenses and the sale of bonus deer tags.

Approval of this ordinance would amend the 2001 Parks and Land Use Department budget by increasing Wildlife Damage Abatement and Claims Program revenues by \$12,000 and purchased services expenditures by \$12,000.
