**JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER AGREEMENT
FOR LISBON ROAD/HAMPTON AVENUE**

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 16th day of July, 2001, by and between Waukesha County hereinafter called the County and the Village of Menomonee Falls hereinafter called the Village.

WITNESS THAT:

WHEREAS the County Trunk Highway System has been designed and constructed to serve trips of longer distance and large traffic volumes, and

WHEREAS Section 83.025(1) Wisconsin Statutes enables the County to enter into a Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement with local units of government containing any terms and conditions that the County and local units deem necessary regarding maintenance or rehabilitation of the highway transferred, and

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto do mutually agree to transfer jurisdictional responsibility for the highways under the conditions described below.

1. The Village agrees to transfer jurisdiction of Lisbon Road/Hampton Avenue (north side) from Pilgrim Road easterly to North 132nd Street, a distance of 1.5 miles to the County.
2. The County agrees to accept transfer of jurisdiction of that portion of the road above referenced.
3. The County agrees that upon acceptance it will assume all costs related to the maintenance of said road including but not limited to driving surface, shoulders, stormwater, snow and ice control, and traffic engineering (signs, signals, pavement markings).
4. The County agrees that upon acceptance, it will assume responsibility for all permits for work within the highway right of way including driveway and utilities.
5. The Village agrees to indemnify and hold the County harmless from any and all claims which may arise out of the Village's ownership, operation and maintenance of that section of Lisbon Road/Hampton Avenue for the period of time prior to the transfer.
6. This transfer shall become effective at the beginning of the month following execution of this Agreement.
7. The COUNTY agrees that as the recipient agency, it will notify property owners along each roadway that a transfer of jurisdiction has occurred and the proper contacts for issues related to roadway maintenance.


FISCAL NOTE

TRANSFER JURISDICTION OF HIGHWAYS

This ordinance authorizes the execution of a Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement in accordance with the adopted Jurisdictional Highway Systems Plan which will transfer 1.5 miles of Lisbon Road/Hampton Avenue (Pilgrim Road to 132nd Street) from the Village of Menomonee Falls to the County. The agreement pertains only to the north side. The south side is the subject of a separate Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement previously adopted by the County Board with the City of Brookfield.

The agreement includes the acceptance by the County of all costs for ongoing maintenance, equipment and repairs. Based on an average operating cost per mile of all roads in the County system, the estimated fiscal 2001 impact of \$2,600 for about four months will be absorbed within the Department of Public Works operating budget. Future years operating costs, estimated at approximately \$8,200 annually, will be requested in the Department's future year budgets. At this time it is not possible to estimate the capital improvement spending impact associated with the transferred road since it has not yet been incorporated into the capital plan.

This ordinance has no additional 2001 budgetary impact as no funding is being appropriated.
