3 AUTHORIZE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND LAND USE TO APPLY FOR
4 AND ACCEPT DNR RECYCLING EFFICIENCY INCENTIVE GRANT

7 WHEREAS, in May 1990, the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors passed Enrolled
8 Resolution #145-7 "Designation of Waukesha County as Responsible Unit for Recycling" as
9 defined in Section 287.09 Wisconsin Statutes with the intent to develop and implement a
10 recycling program for participating municipalities, and
11

12 WHEREAS 25 municipalities passed resolutions authorizing the County as Responsible Unit for
13 recycling on their behalf, and
14

15 WHEREAS the County built a Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) to process and market
16 recyclables from participating municipalities which began operation in 1991 and has served
17 participating municipalities since that time at no charge, and
18

19 WHEREAS the County continues to provide an "effective recycling program," as defined in
20 Section 287.11(2) Wisconsin Statutes, including education and enforcement, and
21

22 WHEREAS the state budget allocated \$1.9 million in 2003 for new DNR Recycling Efficiency
23 Incentive (REI) Grants to qualifying programs, and

25 WHEREAS the County recycling program qualifies for the first year of REI Grants by virtue of
26 its County Responsible Unit status, and


28 WHEREAS the Parks and Land Use 2003 Adopted Budget states that staff will apply for a DNR
29 REI Grant to offset the first year of new program costs for the County Yard and Wood Waste
30 Composting Project to replace or reduce municipal yard waste tipping fees.


32 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS
33 that the Department of Parks and Land Use Director is authorized to apply for and accept the
34 DNR Recycling Efficiency Incentive Grant for 2003 and to complete all necessary applications
35 and reports.

37 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Recycling Efficiency Incentive Grant funds received will be
38 utilized to reduce or replace the planned municipal yard waste tipping fees to cover processing
39 costs to convert yard waste into compost at the County site.
