3 DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND LAND USE TO AMEND BUDGET FOR WILDLIFE
4 DAMAGE PROGRAM TO ALLOW PERMANENT FENCE CONSTRUCTION

6 WHEREAS Waukesha County currently participates in the Wisconsin Wildlife Damage
7 Abatement and Claims Program as authorized by Chapter 29 of Wisconsin Statutes, which is
8 funded by hunters around the state through sales of hunting licenses and bonus deer tags, and
9

10 WHEREAS the annual Department of Parks and Land Use Budget authorizes the Department to
11 serve as the local pass through agency for landowners seeking financial and technical assistance,
12 and

14 WHEREAS the Department contracts with the USDA - Wildlife Services Agency to administer
15 the program, and

17 WHEREAS the USDA - Wildlife Services Agency has provided the county with a revised final
18 budget to allow for permanent fence construction projects for wildlife damage abatement.

20 THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that
21 the Department of Parks and Land Use 2002 budget be modified to accept additional funds from
22 the Wildlife Damage Abatement and Claims Program in the amount of \$12,555 and authorize
23 additional expenditure authority up to \$12,555 to provide for costs associated with the
24 construction of wildlife damage abatement measures as approved by the Wisconsin Department
25 of Natural Resources.


27 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Director of Parks and Land Use is authorized to execute
