7 WHEREAS recent trends in the mortgage market have prompted the refinancing of existing
8 housing and there continues to be economic growth in Waukesha County, and
9

10 WHEREAS changes in standard mortgage forms have resulted in an increase in the number of
11 pages per document from 2.8 pages in 2000 to 4.5 pages in 2002, and
12

13 WHEREAS the Register of Deeds office estimates that by the end of 2002, it will exceed the
14 2002 budget level of 110,000 documents by 29,400 documents for a total of 139,400 by the end
15 of the year, and
16

17 WHEREAS based on the increase of documents estimated to year end, the amount of Real Estate
18 Transfer and Recording Fee revenues received by the Register of Deeds office is projected to be
19 \$800,000 over the 2002 budget level, and

21 WHEREAS the above mentioned increase in volume of documents has resulted in a need for
22 funding in the Register of Deeds office for interdepartmental postage and imaging of the
23 documents.


25 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES

28 cover the costs of processing Real Estate documents.


