AUTHORIZE THE WAUKESHA COUNTY UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN
EXTENSION TO ACCEPT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WAUKESHA 21ST
CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS the School District of Waukesha will subcontract with Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension for the second year of operation of a 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant, and

WHEREAS the School District of Waukesha authorizes the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension to continue to develop and implement youth, family and neighborhood educational and enrichment services in the two existing Community Learning Centers, and

WHEREAS this represents to Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension a continued expansion of educational services to both the Haertel Field (Saratoga) and Phoenix Heights (White Rock) neighborhood revitalization areas, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension in providing coordination of the Community Learning Centers (CLC) will also provide evaluation to determine the level and nature of the CLC activities by students and their families at Saratoga and White Rock Schools and the impact CLC activities have on students' ability to meet Waukesha Public School and State of Wisconsin academic standards, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension is designated as a subgrantee in the amount of \$181,880, and

WHEREAS the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension budget did anticipate this funding request but was not certified until mid 2002 and did not include funding appropriation for the continuation of the two Community Learning Centers in the designated Neighborhood Revitalization Areas since the second-year award was not known at the time of the budget adoption.


THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the Waukesha County University of Wisconsin-Extension be authorized to accept the subgrantee award of up to \$181,880 from the Waukesha School District to continue to provide two contracted program coordinators, contracted support staff, contracted evaluator and supplies and expenses in order to continue to coordinate learning centers servicing the two Housing and Urban Development (HUD) revitalization neighborhoods.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County's University of Wisconsin Extension 2002 budget be modified by increasing Intergovernmental Grant Revenue by \$181,880 and personnel expense appropriation by \$5,000, operating expense appropriation by \$167,786 and Interdepartmental expense appropriation by \$9,094.


