3 APPROVE SETTLEMENT OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION  
4 CASE – GEORGE NOHELTY VS. WAUKESHA COUNTY

7 WHEREAS a claim has been made by a Deputy in the Sheriff's Department through the  
8 workers' compensation division for compensation with regard to injuries allegedly sustained by  
9 him on the job, and  
10

11 WHEREAS after review of the matter and analysis of its impact on future County obligations  
12 with regard to workers' compensation and the State pension system, and  
13

14 WHEREAS the parties have prepared a proposed settlement agreement conditioned upon  
15 approval by the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors, and  
16

17 WHEREAS the County and the claimant, through his counsel, have stipulated and agreed upon a  
18 settlement in this matter that will be in the best interests of the County due to the liability  
19 exposure and cost exposure that protracted litigation in the matter would result, and  
20

21 WHEREAS the County Board of Supervisors believes that the settlement represents a fair and  
22 just settlement of the case.

24 THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES  
25 ORDAIN that, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Workers' Compensation Division, in  
26 exchange for a release of any and all liability which the County may have had in the past or may  
27 have in the future to Mr. Nohelty, settlement in an amount of money not to exceed the sum of  
28 \$220,000.00 and a grant of the right for Mr. Nohelty to receive retiree health insurance benefits,  
29 is hereby authorized.



## FISCAL NOTE

### APPROVE SETTLEMENT OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION CASE – GEORGE NOHELTY VS. WAUKESHA COUNTY

Under the terms of the proposed settlement, the County would pay \$220,000 in settlement of future Workers Compensation and Wisconsin Retirement System Duty Disability claims. Based on the County's best estimates of what those claims would amount to, the settlement payment is the favorable option since they would otherwise exceed the proposed settlement amount in about 2.4 years (in early 2005) and continue through the claimant's lifetime.
