3 REQUEST WAIVER FROM STATE MANDATE: ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
4 CHAPTER 20 REGARDING LOTTERY TAX CREDIT PROCESSING

6 WHEREAS pursuant to Wis.Stat.66.0143, a political subdivision may file a request with the
7 Department of Revenue for a waiver from a state mandate, except for mandates related to health
8 or safety and,
9

10 WHEREAS pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code Tax §20.15, counties are mandated to certify Lottery
11 Tax Credit claims against real estate taxes by sending cards to all improved parcels every five
12 years, known as “pre certification years”, and this mandate is not related to health or safety and,
13

14 WHEREAS the certification process involves printing and mailing the cards, then entering all the
15 responses in the database, all of which is extremely labor intensive and,
16

17 WHEREAS the State of Wisconsin reimburses counties at the rate of \$.70 per card, but said
18 reimbursement is insufficient to cover county costs involved in processing these cards and,
19

20 WHEREAS Waukesha County has developed a system whereby it maintains Lottery Credit
21 Claims on an annual basis by obtaining this information on all properties transferred or improved
22 and,


24 WHEREAS the County is confident its system of maintaining records of Lottery Tax Credit
25 claims is accurate based on the number of late claims made each year and the minimum number
26 of charge backs ordered by the State Lottery Credit Audit Committee for errors, and erasing the
27 current files and sending cards to all improved parcels, as the Administrative Code mandates,
28 will most likely generate a less than favorable return while costing more for taxpayers.


30 NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Waukesha County Board of
31 Supervisors that it hereby requests a waiver from the mandate imposed by Wisconsin
32 Administrative Code Tax §20.15 regarding recertification of the Lottery Tax Credits because the
33 system utilized by Waukesha County is certifiably accurate and will save the county and the state
34 money.


