
20 WHEREAS the estimated purchase price of these trees is \$8,725.

## FISCAL NOTE

### AUTHORIZE THE ACCEPTANCE OF DONATION FOR THE WAUKESHA EXPOSITION CENTER AND APPROPRIATE DONATED FUNDS

Approval of this ordinance modifies the 2003 Parks and Land Use Grounds Maintenance program budget by increasing revenues and operating expense appropriations by \$8,725, related to the acceptance of donation revenues from General Electric. Revenues received offset the cost of trees purchased by the Department and planted by General Electric volunteers.
